

Plant Invaders provides color photographs and information on the identification and management of highly invasive plants affecting aquatic and terrestrial natural habitats in the mid-Atlantic region (i.e., Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and the District of Columbia). The intent of this book is to increase public awareness about invasive plant species, to explain why they are a problem and how they are impacting our environment, especially the native plants and animals that they displace. Because many of these plants are widely used for landscaping, roadside plantings, restoration projects, and other purposes, we also provide alternative plants that make good substitutes for the invasive species. The hope is that once educated on the seriousness of the environmental threats posed by these plants, people will choose to plant native or non-invasive exotic plants and will become active in their removal.
